We will gather at the Pear Tree Inn near Union Station in St. Louis, Missouri for our Spring Conference. The Pear Tree Inn Union Station is at 2211 Market Street, Saint Louis, Missouri, 63103. All our meals will be at the hotel. Reserve your room by registering for the conference. Do not call the hotel to book your room.

If you decide to fly, you will need to arrange transport to the hotel. Besides car rental, Uber, or taxi, St. Louis has a light rail system. The hotel does not have its own shuttle.

Our theme is "Only the Gospel Regenerates Hearts." Many people have recognized a widespread shift in moral standards happening in American culture. Not only do people not know the way of the Lord, they actively reject it. This raises a question of how we can maintain an evangelical approach to ministry now that we recognize this shift has begun.

Opening worship will take place at Martin Luther Lutheran Church (10151 Sappington Road, Saint Louis, Missouri 63128). We will have transportation or ride sharing available to get to the church and back.

Please talk to this person before putting their name down. Payment will be by electronic funds transfer (e-check). Have your checkbook nearby when starting the registration.

Base cost for the conference will be \$220. This pays for our meals, outside speakers, and fellowship expenses. Your total cost will depend on the room options you choose at registration.

Non-attendance fee of \$100 will be charged. While we understand the difficulties of travel to St. Louis, we need this event to be financially viable for those who do attend.
